Write a balanced argument with the title: Should Homework Be Banned in Schools? Present both sides of the argument using appropriate language!	Create a poster showing all the electrical symbols you know and what they mean. Make the poster bright and colourful by adding a border, title and pictures	Write a fact file about the Amazon Rainforest - you could include which continent it is in, which animals live there, what the average temperature and rainfall is, etc.
Write a TripAdvisor review for a place that you have visited. Will it be a positive or a negative review?	Research the person who invented the light bulb and create a fact file about him. This could be presented in any way you desire!	Research an animal that lives in the Amazon Rainforest. Annotate a photo or illustration to describe and explain how its adaptations help it survive in the rainforest.
DT - Cook a healthy, balanced meal for your family. Make a recipe book full of your family's favourite, healthy recipes!	Make a poster or leaflet about how to save electricity. Alternatively, make a poster or leaflet about electrical safety.	Use the internet to research what different companies are doing to try and combat deforestation. (E.g. Not using palm oil in their products.)
Art - Choose any artist or piece of art and try to recreate their style or specific design. Aim to replicate it as close as you can!	Make a list of all the objects in your house that use electricity and explain what the electricity makes the object do.	Create your own Amazon word search puzzles using all the new words you have learned during this project. Challenge a grown up to solve it!
